

2004 May Clinical Exam

These questions are those done in the Exam, as recollected by the candidates – no answers available

1. female 20's getting married in few months – BMI about 25-26 and want reductil to loose weight for the wedding. Mx
2. Lady in 50's comes back after ix and radiology reports disorder DISH – info on disorder given prior to station – discuss the findings with pt
3. Man with COAD comes in with urti and sob. On puffers. Exam findings given. Mx.
4. Viva – wife of pt known to you rings you and informs you h/b with terminal illness has died at home. What to say to her – how to mx this and what is coroner's case.
5. Viva – 14yo girl and mother returns to see you. 14 yo girl is on the pill started a few months ago and recently noted vag d/c. the urine test for chlamydia is positive. Mx of this situation.
6. Long case. Man with dm type 2 ? on OHG sees you. Not had any followup or regular dm review for some years. ROS – peripheral neuropathy. HX /EX/IX/MX.
7. Taxi driver comes in for skin check. Ex and mx
8. Middle aged man comes in requesting for referral to surgeons for varicose veins. He reports to get sore legs. Exam and mx.
9. Child with eczema. Mother using strong steroid cream from a friend and clears the eczema. Now wanting a script for it. Exam and mx
10. Middle aged lady sees you - woke up in the night by her arm which felt “dead” for 2-3 min. unable to lift it up and had to use the other arm to lift – complete resolution. No other symptoms. Exam,Ix and mx.
11. Long case – middle aged man with tiredness for few months. Hx/ex/ix/mx. Haemochromatosis.
12. Examination station – elderly lady – CVS exam – loud murmur noted.
13. Boy – 10-12 yo with painful knee – OSD. exam knee, explain dx to mother and mx

14. Man with dm with rash around perianal region – candida – mx.
