- Educational Scholarship
- Research Scholarship



Background

GPTT is an organisation that conducts general practice vocational training for GP registrars in Tasmania. It provides training within the scope of the RACGP and ACRRM curricula. GPTT has the aim of supporting GP registrars to reach their potential in GP education and training. In working towards this aim GPTT sees the need to make limited funds available to GP registrars to broaden the range of their GP educational experiences and undertake research.

Do you need financial assistance to support your general practice training?

You may wish to apply for funding to;

Attend a **conference** as a participant or to present a paper

Conduct **research**

Undertake a unique **educational** experience

There are 2 scholarships available:

1. Education
2. Research

both are granted twice yearly for an amount determined by the GPTT Board.



Scholarship rules

- * Registrars must be enrolled with General Practice Training Tasmania
- * On completion of the learning experience the GP registrar will write a report to GPTT and do a presentation to GP registrar peers if appropriate.
- * The scholarship is only to be used for activities relevant to general practice
- * You can apply for funding for activities or events you have, or will, attend within the current calendar year.

How are Scholarships granted?

A selection panel, including the GPTT CEO, Director of Training and Program Manager, choose the successful applicants.

The selection panel takes into account the availability of alternative funding sources for the applicant.

The allocation of money is based on educationally sound principles, including:

- * Educational merit
- * Relevance to GP vocational training within the curricula of the RACGP and ACRRM
- * Alignment with the Learning Plan of the GP registrar

How to apply

Applications are available on GPRime. Please login to GPRime and go to forms and documents. Please complete the iform called Registrar Scholarship Fund Application and submit.

How much can you apply for?

The amount available depends on how much the GPTT Board allocates to the Scholarship Fund each year and the number of applicants.

When do you apply?

The Scholarships are awarded in July and December.

Application closing dates are:

1st May
and
1st November

The scholarships will be awarded on :

1st July
and
1st December
